(Tobermory) -

A new business opens Thursday overlooking the waterfront at the tip of the Bruce Peninsula.

Tobermory Brewing Company and Grill is in the old Blue Heron company building and is across from the Crowsnest Pub and Restaurant that is also owned by Matthew and Kristin Buckley.

Renovation work has been underway since November, and Buckley is excited about opening their new business this week.

Buckley says the Tobermory Brewing Company and Grill will offer beer produced locally and many of the ingredients will come from Bruce County.

Buckley adds they will start selling ale first.

They have hired a brewmaster to come with up to four different styles and plan on holding a taste testing party to pick the winner which will become their premium brand for the Tobermory Brewing company and grill.

Buckley says the new operation will have a completely different feel and menu compared to the Crowsnest, which he says will complement each other.

Once fully operational he expects to have roughly 10 employees at the new outlet.
